Introduction

Butler Tech will be launching our Fifth Day Experience (FDE) in February 2020.

The Fifth Day Experience will include 15 Fridays from February to May.

Our goal is to collect student input to design meaningful experiences and opportunities.

Students are not required to attend on the Fridays labeled as an “FDE” but are strongly encouraged to participate in order to increase engagement and opportunity.

The Fifth Day Experience will allow students to select a(n)

- Stay at Home option
- External option
- Campus option

1. **Campus Option:** How often do you plan to attend a campus offering?
(examples include, but not limited to: CCP courses, drivers ed courses, new experiences like a welding lab, drone courses, financial literacy, etc)
2. **External Option:** How often do you plan to take advantage of an external option?
(examples include, but not limited to: working at your job, internship, shadowing, college visits, etc.)
3. **Stay At Home Option:** How often do you plan to stay at home?
(examples include, but not limited to: relax, decompress, work online, watch siblings, etc)
4. **Overall:** Which option do you plan to do most often during the Fifth Day Experience?

5. **Student Voice:** The Fifth Day Experience has been designed so that each student can customize their experience, just like they pick out their own clothes, shoes or music. What are the activities that you would like to experience or that Butler Tech should be offering on these Fridays?
